At Marionville Middle School, we will:

- 1 Increase the percentage of students earning semester A's and B's to over 80% and decrease the percentage of students earning semester D's and F's to below 5%.
- 2 Score 5% higher than state averages in 6th grade and 10% higher than state averages in 7th and 8th grade on the MAP test.
- 3 On average, there will be one incident or less per student of ISS/OSS.
- 4 Communicate with parents regarding academic and discipline progress.
- 5 Seek professional development opportunities to enhance instruction for student achievement.
- 6 75% of the students reading below their grade level will increase their reading level.
- 7 Maintain and update the online curriculum for core subject areas based on the new Missouri Learning Standards.
- 8 Continue to enforce a school wide character education curriculum to promote a safe school environment.
