Mission:

Marionville Middle School is committed to ensuring a safe and quality education for all by developing skills and character necessary for academic and career success.

Goals

I. Increase Student Achievement

- A. The number of students with D's and F's will decrease by 25%
 - i. Increase more one on one student and teacher interaction during advisory/re-teach to re-enforce core content skills for student achievement – Comet Crew Program.
 - ii. No missing assignments in any class AND no D's and F's to qualify for R & R.
 - iii. Continue to track missing assignments weekly in study skills
 - iv. Parent-team conference – the first progress report of the quarter students that are failing two or more core classes will have a mandatory parent conference with grade level teachers.
- B. Evaluate MAP data at regular intervals to improve instruction quality in order to increase the percentage of the same group of students that score proficient/advanced on the MAP test by 5% in communication arts and math.
 - i. Analyze MAP data to determine areas of improvement and develop a plan of action to increase those areas.
 - ii. Set individual goals for students

II. Improve School Climate

- A. Decrease the total number of days students serve in ISS by 5%
 - i. Inform students of appropriate expectations for student behavior
 - ii. Consistently reward students who demonstrate good character
 - iii. Incorporate guest speakers on character education topics, as well as motivation, in the classroom setting
 - iv. Guidance and counseling lessons that focus on etiquette and common courtesy

III. Parent-Teacher Communication

- A. Continue to inform parents of student academic and discipline progress.
 - i. Utilize the Lumen Parent Portal
 - ii. Discipline reports and planners
 - iii. School Reach notification to parents on the days progress reports go home
 - iv. Parents have access to the school website calendar
 - v. Parents have access to teacher contact information through the school website

IV. Professional Development

- A. Teachers and administration will seek professional development to enhance instruction for student achievement.
 - i. Teachers will share information from professional development with colleagues
 - ii. Professional development will focus on student achievement and common core.
